#### "Earth Keepers:" A Nature-Immersive Experience

**Dream Catcher Meadows** is a 1953 farm in Potomac, MD rehabilitated into a sustainable green care farm animal sanctuary. 7th Generation Foundation, Inc., a nonprofit 501c3, operates Dream Catcher Meadows.

Susan Rich uses a biodynamic approach to farming - making soil through in-ground composting, using animal dung to improve the soil microbiome, and removing invasive species. She teaches concepts related to One Health - the inextricable link between human health and environmental health.

She and her children have rescued, raised and care for 15 goats, several chickens, 3 dogs, 4 cats two rescued ponies, an Irish draft horse, 2 emus (Bubbles & Big Bird) and an orphaned Kune Kune pig named Noah.

#### Program Description

"EARTH KEEPERS" is a program for experiential learning in nature on a green care farm animal sanctuary, Dream Catcher Meadows. The farm is a wonderful place to learn about environmental sustainability and experience nature while interacting with gently raised farm animals.

We will begin in our barn "clubhouse" for an agriculture lesson on "inground composting" then explore the farm. We will discuss ways in which environmental sustainability is practiced on the farm (i.e., replacing invasive plants and trees with native ones; in-ground composting to make rich, nutrient dense soil; reducing & removing trash from home, school & community; and animal care). The children shape and develop the topics from week to week. We will forest bathe on a mindfulness log by a neighboring pond, walk through the pasture with the goats, &/or enjoy s'mores by an outdoor campfire.

We aim to teach how to live more gently on Mother Earth and inspire participants toward healthy social relationships. A nature immersive process will facilitate the connection between people and the natural world.

Participants (parents and kids) should bring weatherproof shoes, work gloves, hats, rain jackets, and wear long pants & layers to ensure your comfort during the time outside.
